ACTIONS WE SHOULD TAKE

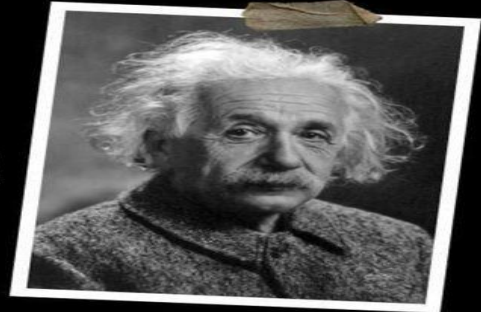
- COLLEGE SHOULD START TEACH STUDENTS HOW TO USE THEIR MINDS PRACTICALLY
